

APPLICATION TIPS & TRICKS



- Start early!
- Use data to support application
- Focus on outcomes of the Main Street organization (not future plans)
- Be proud, but not boastful
- Compose answers in a Word document
- Double and triple check application for consistency
- Have an extra set of eyes on your application

APPLICATION TIPS & TRICKS (CONT.)



- Ensure website is updated/reflects application & MSA logos included
- Letters of support
- High quality images
 - 2000x1500 px, 150 dpi or higher
 - Collages OK, but be prepared to submit original images, if requested

Five Tips for a Winning Application

- + Build your team
 ◆ Be sure your team can keep a secret
- + Tell your story
- + Compile compelling visuals
- + Give yourself plenty of time!
- + Prepare for a marathon





Build Your Team

- + Who should be on your team?
 - State coordinator, board chair, key volunteers or staff
- + Have an idea of who should be on your team if (when!) you win



Tell Your Story



We help people who've been unfairly overlooked in the past. We work honestly and transparently—with young people, women, people of color, and other groups who have been under-served in the past.

- What are the values your program lives by and how are you living out those values?
- What examples support those values?
- How do you tell a story around those examples that always relate back to your values?
- Be specific and have data to support your points (but don't only list numbers)
- Submit everything you possibly can!

Compile Compelling Visuals

- + Invest in quality images
- Images should illustrate and reinforce what's in your application
- Use your photo key as a way to continue telling the story
























Use Your Visuals to Tell Your Story

- Set a budget –for the application and the roll-out


